They serve humanitarian and international development communities, supporting decision-making on disaster management, project design and management and public policy. Current projects include websites monitoring evolving political, social and economic conditions in fragile states.

- Develop content-driven websites using Django CMS, including search engine optimization and website analytics;

- Manage other front end developers, web designers and outsource contractors as required;
